Dressing Guide

 - simple waistcoat or short jacket
 - collarless shirt
 - trousers tucked into long socks or old trousers cut off below the knee
 - black boots or shoes

- plain long-sleeve top
 - white pinafore or apron
 - plain dark shirt
 - plain dark tights
 - lace up shoes or boots
